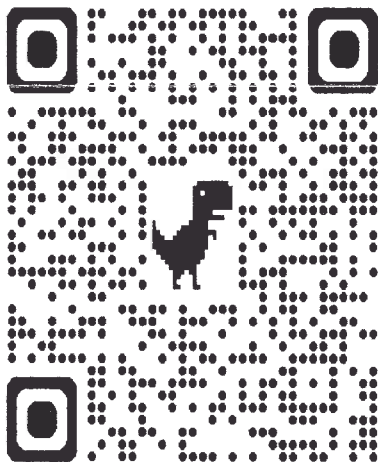
Committed To Post-Disaster Resilience and Restoration
